This annual scholarship seeks to recognize a high school student graduating in the current term and planning to continue their education. The ideal candidate has demonstrated leadership and active participation in CT Youth and Concord Trinity UMC. The CTUMC Youth Scholarship Team will award **one \$1,000.00 scholarship** to the student selected, to be presented on Senior Sunday.

<u>Eligibility:</u> Student must be a graduating senior from a high school in the St. Louis area during the year in which the scholarship award is granted. This student must also be an active member of CT Youth Ministries at Concord Trinity UMC.

<u>Criteria for Scholarship Award:</u> The award is granted based on leadership and participation in the activities/ministries at CTUMC. The Youth Scholarship is NOT based on academics. The following categories constitute the criteria for the scholarship award:

- 1. **Be actively growing in faith**, through participation in Youth Ministry and/or other church-related activities/groups.
- 2. Exhibit a Jesus-Centered Life in our 5 Core Areas. Show us how you've engaged in discipleship, worship, connections/invitation, missions/service & leadership. Help us understand how you seek to impact the world with YOUR intentions.
- 3. <u>One letter of recommendation</u> must accompany this Scholarship application. The letter is required to be from a non-staff church member or family member. The letter should be someone from the CTUMC community.

<u>Personal Interview:</u> Personal interviews will be conducted with each candidate at a pre-arranged time and should last no more than 15 minutes. The members of the CTUMC Youth Scholarship Team will conduct this interview, either in person or on zoom if necessary. After interviews are conducted, a final selection will be made and presented on Senior Recognition Sunday which is scheduled for **MAY 4, 2025.**

Release of Funds: The Youth Scholarship Award will be sent directly to the financial aid office of an accredited technical school, college, or university where the student has been accepted. This will be a one-time \$1,000.00 payment for the student's tuition. In the event the student decides not to pursue higher education, the award will be given to another qualified applicant.
